### **Network Structure**

Network: multiplex

Graphs are internally oriented: chronologically ordered

Nodes: Editions

Edges: two editions are connected when they:

- se13: share same original text-part
- se14: share the same commentary on original text-part
- se15: share translations of the same original text-part
- se16: share different commentaries on the same original text-part (excluded se14)
- se17: share the same commentary on the same commentary or translation
- se19: are "adaptions (book)" and contain a text-part which is *strongly influenced* by the same original text-part
- aw1: are authored by two authors who were alive at time of publication and both had a part published in the same edition
- aw2: are produced by two printers and/or publishers, who published the same paratext and were alive at times of both respective publications
- aw3: are produced by two printers and/or publishers, who published editions that imitate each other for content *and* layout (based on Fingerprint data)
- ec1: have the same book format and their printers and/or publishers were alive at times of both respective publications
- ec2: are published in the same place and their printers and/or publishers were alive at times of both respective publications
- ec3: are of the same book type and printers and/or publishers were alive at times of both respective publications
